

EATS BEAT: Trademark Taste & Grind opens in Midtown with coffee shop and hidden dining room

New to the scene...

Coffee in the front, dinner party in the back. That's the theme of **Trademark Taste & Grind** (38 W. 36 St.), opening Tuesday, April 5 in Midtown. Coffee from Greenpoint's Sweetleaf Coffee Roasters will be served all day, along with pastries. There's a dining room in the back with a menu created by chefs Jeff Haskell and Adrienne Guttieri. Starters include burrata and roasted garlic knots (\$16) and tuna poke (\$16); expect entrees like a 12-ounce pork chop (\$29) and a lamb burger with feta and pepperoncini (\$21). Open daily at 7 a.m. for breakfast, lunch, and dinner, with brunch on weekends.
